

4 Key Principles Essential for Compliance with the HCBS Final Rule:

Choices

Choice is the right, power, or opportunity to choose; option.

Rights

A person's right is that which is morally, legally, or ethically proper.

Opportunities

An opportunity is a good position, chance, or prospect, as for advancement or success; "a set of circumstances that makes it possible to do something".

Integration

Integration means to give or cause to give equal opportunity and consideration to.

One agency provides two opportunities to go on outings per week. Is this in compliance with the HCBS final rule?



The HCBS final rule allows for flexibility and creativity when it comes to implementation, as long as providers can demonstrate that they are offering people the 4 key principles (*Choice, Rights, Opportunities, Integration*).

Providing opportunities to individuals to go on outings is fine, as long as the individuals can chose **not** to participate and are given other choices. These options have to be choices that the individual likes and would select.

Individuals should have choices including, but not limited to:

- What they do each day
- Where they go each day
- Who they are with
- Services and supports
- Who provides the services and supports

"Real Choice includes the opportunity to visit/understand your options"
