### **Choices**

Choice is the right, power, or opportunity to choose; option.

## Rights

A person's right is that which is morally, legally, or ethically proper.

## **Opportunities**

An opportunity is a good position, chance, or prospect, as for advancement or success; "a set of circumstances that makes it possible to do something".

# **Community Integration**

Integration means to give or cause to give equal opportunity and consideration to.


### Supporting Choice

Providing Choices is one of the key principles for compliance with the HCBS final rule.

How can staff support individuals with developmental disabilities who are non-verbal? There are a variety of ways that staff can assist individuals in expressing their choices. A great place to start is to involve the Circle of Support and the people who are most important to the individual. The relationship map creates a picture of who's in the person's life as seen in the image below.

#### How to support individuals who are non-verbal?

- Assess the things, locations and people that the individual enjoys
- Gather information by observing the individual and spending time with them
- Utilize visuals such as pictures to encourage the individual to communicate their preferences
- Have a meeting with the circle of support to review the person's preferences
