

What's Working/What's Not Working

We had a wonderful discussion about *Informed Choice* during the last Vendor Advisory Committee (VAC) on 9/26/19. We reviewed the questions that are provided by CMS that asks that we offer informed choice to each person in response to 5 questions:

- 1. Who provides my paid supports?
- 2. Where do I live?
- 3. Who do I live with?
- 4. What do I do with my time and do I want a paid job (or a different one)?
- 5. What do I do with my resources?

We utilized the Person person-centered thinking skill: What's Working/ What's Not Working, which may help in accomplishing the following: To get a broader perspective, to do pinpoint problem solving and before planning next steps. Through this exercise we reviewed the questions above in response to what is currently working well and where improvements are needed to achieve compliance with the HCBS Final rule.
