

# 4 Key Principles Essential for Compliance with the HCBS Final Rule:

## **Choices**

Choice is the right, power, or opportunity to choose; option.

# **Rights**

A person's right is that which is morally, legally, or ethically proper.

# **Opportunities**

An opportunity is a good position, chance, or prospect, as for advancement or success; "a set of circumstances that makes it possible to do something".

# **Community Integration**

Integration means to give or cause to give equal opportunity and consideration to.

## Implementation of Person-Centered Plans

The person-centered service plan must be developed through a person-centered planning process.



The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) have identified what needs to be included in a person-centered service plan:

How have the 4 key principles for compliance with the HCBS Final Rule been implemented?

#### Choices

- Offers choices to the individual regarding services and supports the individual receives and from whom
- Is timely and occurs at times/locations of convenience to the individual
- The person-centered planning process is driven by the individual
- Includes people chosen by the individual

## **Rights**

- Provides necessary information and support to the individual to ensure that the individual directs the process to the maximum extent possible
- Includes strategies for solving disagreement
- Reflects cultural considerations/uses plain language
- Provides method to request updates

## **Opportunities**

 Conducted to reflect what is important to the individual to ensure delivery of services in a manner reflecting personal preferences and ensuring health and welfare

## **Community Integration**

- Identifies the strengths, preferences, needs (clinical and support), and desired outcomes of the individual
- May include whether and what services are self-directed
