- ii. Networking had its first formal meeting with the Lift program and Moor Field Explorers, AUSD special education programs.

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E. Executive Committee Officers, Introductions

F. Legislative

- i. Voting Solutions for All People (VSAP) Roxy Ortiz provided an update on VSAP:
 - 1. Voter's Choice Act passed to change the methods of voting.
 - 2. LA County, in addition to 9 other counties, will participate in new voting methods. By 2022, all of California is mandated to implement electronic system.
 - 3. \$7.83B in POS (13.9% increase from FY 19/20)
 - 4. Some changes include:
 - a) No more pre-printed rosters. Being replaced by electronic rosters which always for same day voter registration.
 - b) No more paper ballots. Electronic system allows to vote. There are now electronic ballot marking devices.
 - c) There will be electronic interactive ballots.
 - d) No more voting precincts. Being replaced by voting centers. A voter can cast their ballot at any voting center throughout the county regardless of where they live or are registered.
 - e) LAvote.net has all information about the new methods and updates.
 - f) LA county now has 10 days where voting can take place at the voting centers.
 - g) Voting was active from Feb 22nd March 3rd 2020.
 - 5. Regional Center is mandated to help consumers/families register to vote.

V. Report on Board of Directors Meeting, February 11th 2020

VAC Chair Bryan Chacon attended for the group. Important highlights include:

- A. Overview of Data Breach reporting requirements
 - i) IT Manager and Security officer from ELARC present on the reporting requirements and the incident to the board. It was determined that 2 desktops were compromised with Ransomware.
 - j) Ransomware is a form of malware that encrypts a victim's files, locks up the devices and demands ransom in the form of money to obtain the password to access the files.

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- k) ELARC IT conferred with DDS IT to update the Regional Center firewall to recognize and block this malware. ELARC It also directed all staff to change all passwords on desktops. ELARC also disabled remote desktop protocol on all desktops.
- 1) ELARC now has a disclaimer in bold when receiving messages outside of the network that is not internal.
- m) Over 500 individuals affected, it is suspected that no information was taken because this ransomware only locks the computer but it is unknown.
- B. Gloria provided a budget update for FY 19/20 and FY 20/21 which highlighted the governor budget highlight issued in January 2020.
- C. Self-Determination local advisory committee update through 1/22/2020 76 participants completed orientation, three participants expressed interest but did not complete orientation, 28 participants requested to be removed from SDP, three participants either were closed, transferred or deceased. Second selections notifications sent out and are starting the process 26 individuals were notified and selected.

 - A. Liz Rodgers shared information sheet that specifies which PCT skills can assist in meeting HCBS Requirements
