In late 2020, I was promoted to Community Partnerships Manager for the Los Angeles office which provided me with the opportunity to move near my hometown of Whittier, CA. As a Community Partnerships Manager, I focus on developing and strengthening partnerships with California Regional Centers and other organizations by providing updated information regarding current programs and services for assigned territories. I collaborate with regional center staff and support center teams to promote awareness of organization initiatives and campaigns (ex. Toy Drive).

Before joining 24 Hour Home Care, I was a Behavioral Interventionist with Behavioral Health Works in Anaheim, CA. I created and implemented data-based activities to teach and develop verbal or nonverbal communication that replaced aggressive and/or harmful behaviors. I conducted learning sessions with individuals served and their loved ones to teach personal care through ABA techniques and positive reinforcement.

I am proud to serve the Eastern Los Angeles Regional Center as I was born and raised within their catchment area and understand the disparities and inequities that are experienced by ESL families. I strive to help bridge the disparities and inequities within the community by amplifying the voices of those we serve and being a resource to others through continuous learning such as participating in Person-Centered Thinking training.
