# DDS Directive Extends SOE Absence Billing to 8/31/2020

On July 17, 2020, the Department of Developmental Services (DDS) released a directive that extends retention payments (absence billing) to nonresidential providers for consumer absences through August 31, 2020.

The directive also outlines a framework regarding alternative ways to deliver services by the non-residential providers. It includes preliminary list of services and supports that would be eligible for billing under an alternative delivery service model. Sample enclosures of forms were included with the directive. DDS is planning on having the alternative ways to deliver services effective September 1, 2020.

The directive also waives the half-day billing requirements of Welfare and Institutions Code section 4690.6. The waiver of the half day billing requirements remains in effect for the duration of this directive unless extended by the DDS Director.
