IMPORTANT: Correspondence to Non Residential Providers re: End of Absence Billing/Required Documents

The Department of Developmental Services (DDS) issued a directive on July 17th that extended State of Emergency (SOE) absence billings until August, 31, 2020. The directive also includes a framework for the delivery of alternative services for those non-residential services that will go into effect September 1, 2020. Certain documents should be submitted to the Regional Center by September 1, 2020 per the DDS directive.

Phase I General Distribution: on April 10th, 2020,

HHS distributed \$50B to eligible providers who bill Medicare Fee-for-Service (FFS). The two rounds of distribution included over 300,000 providers. The application period for Phase 1 ended on June 3rd, 2020.

• Phase 2 General Distribution: An expected distribution of \$15B to providers who take part in Medicaid/CHIP programs, Medicaid managed care plans, or who provide dental care, to include those who were unable to apply for the Phase 1 distribution or who experienced a change in ownership. Please note providers of regional center services are Medicaid providers and are encouraged to apply.
