 - Challenges being faced with FMS: Crisis with FMS providers due to stopping services and putting individuals on waiting lists. There are individuals that may not be being paid on time.
 - Working at micro-level to work with individual situations
 - Working at regional macro level with FMS providers who have not been paying individuals.
 - Working at State level
 - Ombudsman to support with these situations to resolve individual situations and address the challenges at the state level.
- DDS Directives: All following directives are on the DDS website.
 - Program Directives
 - SDP Regional Center Payment of FMS Services for SDP participants
 - Costs of FMS services no longer come out of the budget
 - SDP: Initial Person-Centered Plan and Pre-Enrollment Transition Supports Guidance
 - Strategy around how to fund this through the individual's plan
 - Needed to be help in the spending plan development included
 - Transition was beyond PCP so it was revamped how this would be approached.
 - Beginning 10/1/23 changes:
 - Will be initial funding of \$1,000
 - Initial pre-enrollment transition support and can be free through vendored services
 - New service code: 099: ELARC will put out more information regarding this service for the provider community
 - SDP: FMS Payments and Notifications
 - RC must notify the FMS within 3 days of changes being made.
 - RC must pay FMS weekly to address the cash flow issue to enable them to make payroll.
 - SDP: Adjustment to Individual Budgets
 - As a vendored provider, if you provide the same services as a vendored program, you will also receive the rate increase.

ELARC Updates

- o Difficulties with the FMS and how they are interacting with the participants.
- o Growing SD participants with the number now in the triple digits.
- Statewide effort to work on the FMS crisis.
- Existing vendors are welcome to become and FMS to provide services to the families.

• LVAC Funds

- By law required to have a committee determines how to utilize funds to support the SDP implementation.
- State released approximately \$94,600 on 9/28/22 for LVAC to decide how to utilize this.
- Will meet to review how to spend the funds at the 10/15/22 from 6-8 Tuesday meeting

- Meet Brendali Maldonado, Participant Choice Specialist
 - o State of CA mandated that each RC would have Participant Choice positions.
 - Helping individuals to understand SDP, training and supporting families, monthly orientations and create support for SDP within the community.
 - o Meet with SDP Service Coordinators weekly.
