

CHLA Research Study: Mental Health in Teens with Autism

Purpose: We hope to understand mental health in teens (ages 14-17) with confirmed or suspected autism.

Study Activities: Families will attend 4 visits over 1 year at CHLA, which include interviews, electroencephalogram (EEG) and eyetracking tasks, and surveys. Visits last 2-4 hours each, with breaks.

Eligibility: Teens (14-17 years old) with confirmed or suspected autism, without intellectual disability, and with or without depression.

Risks: Minimal risks are anticipated and like daily activities
