IMPORTANT TRAINING: WINTER WEATHER PREPAREDNESS

Dear Service Provider,

Are you ready for El Nino? How will you provide services if there is flooding or a power outage? Are the individuals you serve prepared? How can you help them?

As you likely have seen in recent media reports, historically heavy rain is predicted to begin in January and extend into March, with risk of flooding and other weather related challenges including street closures and power outages. There is specific concern regarding potential flooding along the Arroyo Seco due to issues with a dam upstream. Communities we serve such as Highland Park and South Pasadena could be affected by this potential flooding. It is expected that all communities will be impacted to some degree by the intense winter weather that is predicted. It is important to get the facts and get prepared.

ELARC has partnered with the Los Angeles County Office of Emergency Management to present on how to prepare for the extreme winter weather that is predicted. This very important training will be held on January 6 from 10:00 am to 12 noon in the ELARC Auditorium located at 1000 S. Fremont in Alhambra.
