



The CHAT (CHild Abuse Treatment) Program at Foothill Family

Offering counseling and case management services to children 0 – 17 years of age.

The criteria to be eligible to receive services through this program is for children to have either been, physically or sexually abused, neglected, live in high risk neighborhoods where they are exposed to violence or there is danger of gang involvement, been exposed to domestic violence and/or any other type of victimization or exposure to a crime.

Our program is comprised of a team of therapists who will be offering individual and group therapy for children along in English and Spanish.

Counseling is provided at the school or at any one of our Foothill Family sites/and or at the child's home.

Children who demonstrate any of the following behaviors may be good candidates for CHAT services:

- Frequent disruptive behaviors
- Conflicts with peers and/or adults
- Aggression
- Depression
- Inappropriate sexual behavior
- Excessive anxiety
- Repeated somatic complaints (headaches, stomach aches, etc.)
- Withdrawn behavior
- Angry Outbursts
- Drastic changes in behavior

*This program will provide counseling and case management services to children who are **without** Medi-cal benefits.*
